

TFS PAINTBALL & AIRSOFT — PARTICIPANT WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & ASSUMPTION OF RISK

IMPORTANT — THIS IS A LEGALLY BINDING DOCUMENT. READ THE ENTIRE FORM CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.

1. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I wish to participate in paintball and/or airsoft games (the "Game") operated by TFS Paintball & Airsoft (the "Sponsor"). I recognize that participation involves risks including, but not limited to:

- Impact injuries from paintballs or airsoft BBs (bruising, welts, lacerations)
- Eye or facial injuries if protective equipment is not worn or improperly fitted
- Equipment malfunction; trips, slips, and falls on uneven terrain
- Collisions with participants or structures; physical exhaustion
- Aggravation of pre-existing medical conditions

Despite these and other risks, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Sponsor or its staff, and assume full responsibility for my participation. I acknowledge that serious injury or death is a possible consequence.

2. RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS & INDEMNITY

In consideration of being permitted to participate, I agree:

- TO WAIVE ALL CLAIMS against TFS Paintball & Airsoft, its directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and representatives (the "Releasees");
- TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, or expense I may suffer due to any cause, including the Releasees' own negligence;
- TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees from any claim brought by me or on my behalf, including all legal costs and damages;
- That this Agreement is binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, and assigns.

Nothing herein releases the Releasees from liability for gross negligence or willful misconduct. If any part of this Agreement is found invalid, the remainder remains in full force.

3. HEALTH DECLARATION & MEDICAL CONSENT

I certify I am in satisfactory physical condition and have no medical condition aggravated by vigorous activity, unless disclosed to the Sponsor in writing. I consent to emergency medical treatment if I am unable to consent for myself, and agree the Releasees are not responsible for related costs.

4. PHOTOGRAPHY & MEDIA RELEASE

I grant the Sponsor permission to photograph and/or video record my participation for promotional purposes without compensation. I may opt out in writing at registration.

5. SAFETY RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

Violations may result in immediate removal without refund.

Eye & Face Protection

- Full-seal ASTM-rated goggles/mask MUST be worn at all times in all "goggles-on" zones, including when eliminated or the game is over
- Masks must be properly fitted; lenses must be undamaged and unmodified
- If mask fogs, call "Blind Man!" — keep eyes covered and wait for a referee escort to a safe zone

Marker Safety

- Treat every marker as loaded; safety on and finger off trigger in all staging areas and safe zones
- Barrel blocking device required whenever not actively on the field; rags/squeegees are not acceptable
- 300 fps max (paintball) / 350 fps CQB / 400 fps outdoor (airsoft); semi-auto only, no ramping or burst-fire
- Do not modify, tamper with, or disassemble any equipment

Field Conduct

- Follow all staff and referee instructions; do not argue calls
- Stay within field boundaries; no blind-firing; no climbing trees or tampering with structures
- Call hits honestly; exit field immediately upon elimination with marker raised and calling "Out!"
- No physical contact, fighting, abusive language, or aggressive behaviour toward players or staff

Prohibited Items & Substances

- Alcohol, illegal drugs, and marijuana (including legal recreational cannabis) are strictly prohibited. Participants believed to be impaired will be denied entry without refund
- Real firearms, edged weapons, pyrotechnics, and prohibited weapons are not permitted on premises

6. MINORS UNDER 18

A parent or legal guardian must sign this waiver on behalf of any minor participant. The parent/guardian consents to the minor's participation, assumes all risks on the minor's behalf, and agrees to release and indemnify the Releasees. A new signed waiver is required each visit.
